- 17 (b) Costs to Be Reviewed.—The study under sub-
- 18 section (a) shall include review of the costs of transporting
- 19 such oil—

1	(1) under long-term time charters and spot-
2	market voyage charters; and
3	(2) to United States ally countries, such as
4	North Atlantic Treaty Organization member coun-
5	tries, Israel, and Japan, that have historically relied
6	on Russian or Iranian oil imports.
