

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 702
OFFERED BY MR. POMPEO OF KANSAS

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 SEC. 5. STUDY OF REFINERY SECTOR IMPACT.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Energy, in con-
3 junction with other relevant agencies, shall conduct a
4 study of regulatory barriers and mandates currently and
5 prospectively impacting the oil refining sector.

6 (b) FOCUS.—The study required under subsection (a)
7 shall focus on—

8 (1) the Renewable Fuel Standard; and

9 (2) ozone national ambient air quality stand-
10 ards.

11 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 6 months after the date
12 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit to
13 Congress a report that describes the results of the study
14 conducted under subsection (a), including an identification
15 and quantification, where feasible, of the following factors
16 when examined in conjunction with a lifting of the crude
17 oil export ban under section 2 of this Act:

18 (1) Impacts on refining jobs.

19 (2) Impacts on refinery utilization and optimi-
20 zation.

1 (3) Impact on consumers and gas prices.

2 (4) Impacts on national security as it relates to
3 the continued viability of the United States oil refin-
4 ing sector.
