1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the " Act
5	of 2023".

1	SEC. 2. PARITY IN MEDICARE PAYMENTS FOR HOSPITAL
2	OUTPATIENT DEPARTMENT SERVICES FUR-
3	NISHED OFF-CAMPUS.
4	(a) In General.—Section 1833(t)(3) of the Social
5	Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(t)(3)) is amended—
6	(1) in subparagraph (D), in the matter pre-
7	ceding clause (i), by striking "The Secretary" and
8	inserting "Subject to subparagraph (H), the Sec-
9	retary"; and
10	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
11	paragraph:
12	"(H) Parity in fee schedule amount
13	FOR CERTAIN SERVICES FURNISHED BY AN
14	OFF-CAMPUS OUTPATIENT DEPARTMENT OF A
15	PROVIDER.—
16	"(i) In general.—Subject to clauses
17	(v) and (vi), in the case of specified OPD
18	services (as defined in clause (iii)) that are
19	furnished during 2024 or a subsequent
20	year by an off-campus outpatient depart-
21	ment of a provider (as defined in clause
22	(iv)), there shall be substituted for the
23	medicare OPD fee schedule amount estab-
24	lished under subparagraph (D) for such
25	service and year, determined prior to appli-
26	cation of any geographic or other adjust-

1	ments under this subsection (including ad-
2	justments under paragraph (17)), an
3	amount equal to the payment amount
4	under subsection (i) for such service and
5	year, determined prior to application of
6	any geographic or other adjustments under
7	such subsection (including adjustments
8	under paragraph (2)(D)(iv) of such sec-
9	tion).
10	"(ii) Not budget neutral imple-
11	MENTATION.—In making any budget neu-
12	trality adjustments under this subsection
13	for 2024 or a subsequent year, the Sec-
14	retary shall not take into account the re-
15	duced expenditures that result from the
16	application of this subparagraph.
17	"(iii) Specified opd services de-
18	FINED.—For purposes of this subpara-
19	graph, the term 'specified OPD services'
20	means covered OPD services included in
21	the ambulatory payment classification
22	groups for drug administration services.
23	"(iv) Off-Campus outpatient de-
24	PARTMENT OF A PROVIDER DEFINED.—
25	For purposes of this subparagraph, the

1	term 'off-campus outpatient department of
2	a provider' means a department of a pro-
3	vider (as defined in section 413.65(a)(2) of
4	title 42, Code of Federal Regulations) that
5	is not located—
6	"(I) on the campus (as such term
7	is defined in such section
8	413.65(a)(2)) of such provider; and
9	"(II) within the distance (de-
10	scribed in such definition of campus)
11	from a remote location of a hospital
12	facility (as defined in such section
13	413.65(a)(2)).
14	"(v) Transition.—The Secretary
15	shall provide for a 4-year phase-in of the
16	application of clause (i), with clause (i)
17	being fully applicable for covered OPD
18	services furnished during 2027 or a subse-
19	quent year.
20	"(vi) Authority to adjust pay-
21	MENT AMOUNT.—The Secretary may ad-
22	just the payment amount for covered OPD
23	services described in clause (i) if the Sec-
24	retary determines that the application of

1	clause (i) will create access problems for
2	individuals enrolled under this part.".
3	(b) Implementation.—Section 1833(t)(12) of the
4	Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(t)(12)) is amend-
5	ed—
6	(1) in subparagraph (D), by striking "and" at
7	the end;
8	(2) in subparagraph (E), by striking the period
9	at the end and inserting "; and; and
10	(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
11	paragraph:
12	"(F) the determination of any payment
13	amount under paragraph (3)(H), including the
14	transition under clause (v) of such paragraph
15	and any adjustment under clause (vi) of such
16	paragraph.".
