 - 5 Transparency at BARDA Act".

1 SEC. 2. DURATION OF AGREEMENTS WITH BARDA.

2 Section 319L(c)(5) of the Public Health Service Act 3 (42 U.S.C. 247d-7e(c)(5)) is amended by adding at the 4 end the following: 5 "(I) Duration.—A contract, grant, coop-6 erative agreement, or other transaction entered 7 into under this section shall be for a period not 8 to exceed five years, except that, in first award-9 ing the grant or entering into the contract, cooperative agreement, or other transaction, the 10 11 Secretary may provide for a longer duration, 12 not exceeding 10 years, if the Secretary deter-13 mines that complexities or other difficulties in 14 performance under the contract, grant, cooperative agreement, or other transaction justify 15 16 such a period. The contract, grant, cooperative 17 agreement, or other transaction shall be renew-18 able for additional periods, none of which shall

19 exceed five years. The Secretary shall notify the

vendor within 90 days of a determination by the

21 Secretary to modify, renew, extend, or termi-

22 nate such contract, grant, cooperative agree-

23 ment, or other transaction.".
