2	This Act may be cited as the "WiFi Capable Mobile
3	Devices Act of 2017".
4	SEC. 2. WIFI FOR LIFELINE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM RECIPI-
5	ENTS.
6	(a) Rulemaking and Outreach Program.—Not
7	later than 18 months after the date of the enactment of
8	this Act, the Federal Communications Commission shall—
9	(1) issue rules to ensure that providers of mo-
10	bile broadband Internet access service that is sup-
11	ported through the Lifeline Assistance Program
12	offer to subscribers of such service, mobile devices
13	that are capable of receiving a WiFi or other wire-
14	less broadband signal using unlicensed spectrum and
15	are capable of tethering with other compatible hard-

20	(b) DEFINITIONS.—As used in this Act—

to another device whereby one device connects to the

4	nications using the standard designated as 802.11
