## A BILL

To amend the Federal Power Act with respect to the criteria  
and process to qualify as a qualifying conduit hydropower  
facility.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. QUALIFYING CONDUIT HYDROPOWER FACILI-**  
4 **TIES.**

5 Section 30(a) of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.  
6 823a(a)) is amended—

- 1           (1) in paragraph (2)(C), by striking “45 days”  
2           and inserting “30 days”; and  
3           (2) in paragraph (3)(C)—  
4           (A) in clause (i), by adding “and” after  
5           the semicolon;  
6           (B) by striking clause (ii); and  
7           (C) by redesignating clause (iii) as clause  
8           (ii).
