(1) REPEAL.—Section 399Z-1(f)(3) of the
 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280h-5(f)(3))
 is amended by striking subparagraph (B).

4 (2) CONFORMING CHANGE.—Section 399Z5 1(f)(3) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
6 280h-5(f)(3)) is amended by striking "LIMITA7 TIONS" and all that follows through "Any provider
8 of services" and inserting "LIMITATION.—Any pro9 vider of services".

(b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
399Z-1(l) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
280h-5(l)) is amended by striking "2010 through 2014"
and inserting "2019 through 2024".
