 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Comprehensive Im5 munosuppressive Drug Coverage for Kidney Transplant
6 Patients Act of 2019".

SEC. 2. EXTENDED MONTHS OF COVERAGE OF IMMUNO SUPPRESSIVE DRUGS FOR KIDNEY TRANS PLANT PATIENTS AND OTHER RENAL DIALY SIS PROVISIONS.

5 (a) MEDICARE ENTITLEMENT TO IMMUNO6 SUPPRESSIVE DRUGS FOR KIDNEY TRANSPLANT RECIPI7 ENTS.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 226A(b)(2) of the
9 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 426–1(b)(2)) is
10 amended by inserting "(except for eligibility for en11 rollment under part B solely for purposes of cov12 erage of immunosuppressive drugs described in sec13 tion 1861(s)(2)(J))" before ", with the thirty-sixth
14 month".

15 (2) INDIVIDUALS ELIGIBLE ONLY FOR COV16 ERAGE OF IMMUNOSUPPRESSIVE DRUGS.—

17 (A) IN GENERAL.—Section 1836 of the So18 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 13950) is amend19 ed—

20 (i) by striking "Every" and inserting
21 "(a) IN GENERAL.—EVERY"; and
22 (ii) by adding at the end the following
23 new subsection:

24 "(b) INDIVIDUALS ELIGIBLE FOR IMMUNO-25 SUPPRESSIVE DRUG COVERAGE.—

1	"(1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided under
2	paragraph (2), every individual whose insurance ben-
3	efits under part A have ended (whether before, on,
4	or after January 1, 2022) by reason of section
5	226A(b)(2) is eligible to enroll in the insurance pro-
6	gram established by this part solely for purposes of
7	coverage of immunosuppressive drugs in accordance
8	with section 1837(m).
9	"(2) Exception if other health insur-
10	ANCE COVERAGE IS AVAILABLE.—
11	"(A) IN GENERAL.—An individual de-
12	scribed in paragraph (1) shall not be eligible for
13	enrollment in the insurance program described
14	in such paragraph with respect to any period in
15	which the individual—
16	"(i) is enrolled in a group health plan,
17	as defined in section $2791(a)(1)$ of the
18	Public Health Service Act, or individual
19	health insurance coverage, as defined in
20	section $2791(b)(5)$ of such Act, as deter-
21	mined in accordance with subparagraph

14	"(B) ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATIONS.—
15	"(i) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary, in
16	consultation with the Administrator of So-
17	cial Security, shall establish procedures for
18	determining whether an individual de-
19	scribed in paragraph (1) who is to be en-
20	rolled in the insurance program described
21	in such paragraph meets the requirements
22	for such enrollment under this subsection,
23	including the requirement that the indi-
24	vidual not have other health insurance cov-
25	erage as described in subparagraph (A).

1	"(ii) Attestation regarding
2	OTHER COVERAGE.—The procedures estab-
3	lished under clause (i) shall include a re-

8	insurance coverage; and
9	"(II) update such attestation—
10	"(aa) on an annual basis; or
11	"(bb) if the health insurance
12	coverage situation of the indi-
13	vidual has changed.
14	"(C) Identification and reduction of
15	IMPROPER PAYMENTS.—The Secretary, in con-
16	sultation with the Administrator of Social Secu-
17	rity, shall—
18	"(i) establish procedures to ensure
19	that any information provided with respect
20	to other health insurance coverage de-
21	scribed in subparagraph (A) of this para-
22	graph for an individual described in para-
23	graph (1) is provided to the appropriate
24	medicare administrative contractor for pur-
25	poses of identifying any improper pay-

ments made with respect to immuno suppressive drug coverage under this part;
 and

4 "(ii) provide education to prevent or
5 reduce such improper payments, including
6 education through the improper payment
7 outreach and education program under
8 section 1847A(h).".

9 (B) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Sections
10 1837, 1838, and 1839 of the Social Security
11 Act (42 U.S.C. 1395p, 42 U.S.C. 1395q, 42
12 U.S.C. 1395r) are each amended by striking
13 "1836" and inserting "1836(a)" each place it

(b) ENROLLMENT FOR INDIVIDUALS ONLY ELIGIBLE
16 FOR COVERAGE OF IMMUNOSUPPRESSIVE DRUGS.—Sec17 tion 1837 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395p)
18 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub19 section:

"(m)(1) Any individual who is eligible under section
1836(b) to enroll in the medical insurance program established under this part for purposes of coverage of immunosuppressive drugs may enroll only in such manner and
form as may be prescribed by regulations, and only during
an enrollment period described in this subsection.

1 "(2) An individual described in paragraph (1) whose 2 entitlement for hospital insurance benefits under part A ends by reason of section 226A(b)(2) prior to January 1, 3 4 2022, may enroll beginning on the first day of the third month before the month in which the individual first satis-5 fies section 1836(b), or a date specified by the Secretary 6 7 prior to the first date on which coverage is effective under 8 section 1838(g)(2), whichever is later. In implementing 9 the preceding sentence, the Secretary shall consider procedures to expedite the enrollment of such an individual if 10 practicable for purposes of providing continued coverage 11 12 of immunosuppressive drugs for such individual pursuant 13 to section 1838(g)(2).

"(3) An individual described in paragraph (1) whose
entitlement for hospital insurance benefits under part A
ends by reason of section 226A(b)(2) on or after January
1, 2022, shall be deemed to have enrolled in the medical
insurance program established by this part for purposes
of coverage of immunosuppressive drugs.

20 "(4) The Secretary shall establish a process under 21 which an individual described in paragraph (1) whose 22 other health insurance coverage described in section 23 1836(b)(2)(A), or coverage under this part (including the 24 medical insurance program established under this part for 25 purposes of coverage of immunosuppressive drugs) is terminated voluntarily or involuntary may enroll or reenroll,

first day of the month in which the individual first
satisfies section 1836(b).

"(2) In the case of such an individual who enrolls (or reenrolls) in part B for coverage of immunosuppressive drugs under paragraph (2) or (4)
of section 1837(m), such individual's coverage period
shall begin on January 1, 2022 (or such earlier date
as the Secretary may specify if practicable for purposes of providing continued coverage of immuno-

1	suppressive drugs for such an individual), or the
2	month following the month in which the individual
3	so enrolls (or reenrolls), whichever is later.

Such premium shall be equal to 35 percent 18 of the monthly actuarial rate for enrollees age 65 and over, 19 determined according to paragraph (1), for that suc-20 ceeding calendar year. The monthly premium of each indi-21 vidual enrolled for coverage of immunosuppressive drugs 22 under section 1836(b) for each month shall be the amount 23 promulgated in this subsection. Such amount shall be ad-24 justed in accordance with subsections (c), (f), and (i), but shall not be adjusted under subsection (b).". 25

(e) GOVERNMENT CONTRIBUTION.—Section 1844(a)

"(4) a Government contribution equal to the es-8 9 timated aggregate reduction in premiums payable 10 under part B that results from establishing the pre-11 mium at 35 percent of the actuarial rate under sec-12 tion 1839(j) instead of 50 percent of the actuarial 13 rate for individuals who enroll only for the purpose 14 of coverage of immunosuppressive drugs under sec-15 tion 1836(b)."; and

16 (3) by adding the following sentence at the end

18 added by paragraph (2) of this subsection:

19 "The Government contribution under paragraph (4)
20 shall be treated as premiums payable and deposited
