FULL COMMITTEE VIRTUAL MARKUP

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 23, 2021

The Committee on Energy and Commerce met, pursuant to notice, at 10:35 a.m., a quorum being present, for a virtual markup on the Committee's WebEx platform, Hon. Frank Pallone, Jr. (Chairman of the committee) presiding. The business before the Committee was consideration and markup of three bills pending before the full Committee. The following actions were taken:

1. <u>H.R. 3291</u>, the "Assistance, Quality, and Affordability Act of 2021", was ordered reported favorably to the House, **amended**, by a roll call vote, 32-24 (*Roll call No. 31*) (**Final Passage**).

The following amendments were offered during consideration of H.R. 3291:

- An Amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) #1 (AQUAFCCPANS 01), offered by Mr. Tonko (D-NY), was agreed to by a voice vote.
- Amendment to the Tonko AINS #1a (FCAMDT7), offered by Mrs. Rodgers (R-WA), was defeated by a roll call vote: 23-30 (*Roll call no. 29*).
- Amendment to the Tonko AINS #1b (<u>AQUAFCAMDT 01</u>), offered by Mr. Ruiz (D-CA), was agreed to by a voice vote.
- Amendment to the Tonko AINS #1c (FCAMDT8), offered by Mr. McKinley (R-WV), was defeated by a roll call vote: 25-31 (*Roll call no. 30*).
- Amendment to the Tonko AINS #1d (<u>DINGELLAMDTHR3291_01</u>), offered by Mrs. Dingell (D-MI), was agreed to by a voice vote.
- **Amendment to the Tonko AINS #1e** (<u>FCAMDT3</u>), offered by Mr. Curtis (R-UT), was withdrawn.
- Amendment to the Tonko AINS #1f (<u>BARRAG_028</u>), offered by Ms. Barragán (D-CA), was agreed to by a voice vote.
- 2. <u>H.R. 3293</u>, the "Low-Income Water Customer Assistance Programs Act of 2021", was ordered reported favorably to the House, **as amended**, by a roll call vote: 32-24 (*Roll call No. 33*) (**Final Passage**).

The following amendments were offered during consideration of H.R. 3293:

- Amendment #1 (3293FC 01), offered by Mr. Duncan (R-SC), was defeated by a roll call vote: 24-32 (*Roll call No. 32*).
- Amendment #2 (3293FC_04), offered by Mr. Crenshaw (R-TX), was withdrawn.

- Amendment #3 (2467_018), offered by Mr. Crenshaw, was defeated by a roll call vote: 24-31 (*Roll call No. 36*).
- **Amendment** #4 (2467_017), offered by Mr. Bilirakis (R-FL), was defeated by a roll call vote: 23-29 (*Roll call No. 37*).

- Amendment #7 (2467_012), offered by Ms. Lesko (R-AZ), was defeated by a roll call vote: 21-31 (*Roll call No. 40*).
- Amendment #8 (2467_016), offered by Mr. Carter (R-GA), was defeated by a roll call vote: 21-31 (*Roll call No. 41*).
- **Amendment #9** (2467_01), offered by Mr. McKinley, was defeated by a roll call vote: 22-30 (*Roll call No. 42*).
