FULL COMMITTEE Hybrid Markup

WEDNESDAY, JULY 13, 2022

The Committee on Energy and Commerce met, pursuant to notice, at 11:04 a.m., a quorum being present, for a hybrid markup in the John D. Dingell Room, 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building, and remotely via the Committee's Webex platform, Hon. Frank Pallone, Jr. (Chairman of the committee) presiding. The business before the Committee was consideration and markup of five bills pending before the full Committee. The following actions were taken:

1. <u>H.R. 7624</u>, the "Spectrum Innovation Act of 2022," was ordered reported favorably to the House, **amended**, by a roll call vote of 52 yeas to 0 nays (*Roll call no. 128*) (**Final Passage**).

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 7624:

• An Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute #1 (<u>H7624 ANS FC 01</u>), offered by Mr. Latta, was agreed to by a voice vote.

The Committee recessed for votes from 11:49 a.m. until 12:48 p.m.

2. <u>H.R. 4275</u>, the "Ensuring Phone and Internet Access Through Lifeline and Affordable Connectivity Program Act of 2022," was ordered reported favorably to the House, **as amended**, by a roll call vote of 48 yeas to 0 nays (*Roll call no. 129*) (Final Passage).

No amendments were offered during consideration of H.R. 4275.

3. <u>H.R. 4990</u>, the "Institute for Telecommunication Sciences Codification Act" or the "ITS Codification Act," was ordered reported favorably to the House, **as amended**, by a roll call vote of 51 yeas to 0 nays (*Roll call no. 130*) (**Final Passage**).

No amendments were offered during consideration of H.R. 4990.

4. <u>H.R. 7132</u>, the "Safe Connections Act of 2022," was ordered reported favorably to the House, **as amended**, by a roll call vote of 53 yeas to 0 nays (*Roll call no. 131*) (**Final Passage**).

No amendments were offered during consideration of H.R. 7132.

5. <u>H.R. 3630</u>, the "Lymphedema Treatment Act," was ordered reported favorably to the House, **amended**, by a voice vote (Final Passage).

The following amendment was offered during consideration of H.R. 3630:

• An Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute #1 (<u>H3630-AINS_01</u>), offered by Ms. Schakowsky, was agreed to by a voice vote.
