- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Promoting a Safe
- 5 Internet for Minors Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. ONLINE SAFETY FOR MINORS.
- 7 (a) AMENDMENT.—Subtitle A of the Protecting Chil-
- 8 dren in the 21st Century Act (15 U.S.C. 6551 et seq,)
