To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize pro-
grams related to health professions education, and for
other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF PROGRAMS RELATED**
4 **TO HEALTH PROFESSIONS EDUCATION.**

5 (a) **CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE.**—Section 736(i) of
6 the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 293(i)) is
7 amended by striking “\$23,711,000 for each of fiscal years

1 2021 through 2025” and inserting “\$28,422,000 for each
2 of fiscal years 2026 through 2030”.

3 (b) SCHOLARSHIPS FOR DISADVANTAGED STUDENTS;
4 LOAN REPAYMENTS AND FELLOWSHIPS REGARDING FAC-
5 ULTY POSITIONS; EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE IN THE
6 HEALTH PROFESSIONS REGARDING INDIVIDUALS FROM
7 DISADVANTAGED BACKGROUNDS.—Section 740 of the
8 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 293d) is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “\$51,470,000
10 for each of fiscal years 2021 through 2025” and in-
11 serting “\$55,041,000 for each of fiscal years 2026
12 through 2030”;

13 (2) in subsection (b), by striking “\$1,190,000
14 for each of fiscal years 2021 through 2025” and in-
15 serting “\$2,310,000 for each of fiscal years 2026
16 through 2030”; and

17 (3) in subsection (c), by striking “\$15,000,000
18 for each of fiscal years 2021 through 2025” and in-
19 serting “\$16,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2026
20 through 2030”.

21 (c) PRIMARY CARE TRAINING AND ENHANCE-
22 MENT.—Section 747(c)(1) of the Public Health Service
23 Act (42 U.S.C. 293k(c)(1)) is amended by striking
24 “\$48,924,000 for each of fiscal years 2021 through 2025”

1 and inserting “\$49,924,000 for each of fiscal years 2026
2 through 2030”.

3 (d) TRAINING IN GENERAL, PEDIATRIC, AND PUBLIC
4 HEALTH DENTISTRY.—Section 748(f) of the Public
5 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 293k–2(f)) is amended by
6 striking “\$28,531,000 for each of fiscal years 2021
7 through 2025” and inserting “\$42,673,000 for each of fis-
8 cal years 2026 through 2030”.

9 (e) AREA HEALTH EDUCATION CENTERS.—Section
10 751(j)(1) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
11 294a(j)(1)) is amended by striking “\$41,250,000 for each
12 of fiscal years 2021 through 2025” and inserting
13 “\$47,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2026 through
14 2030”.

15 (f) EDUCATION AND TRAINING RELATING TO GERI-
16 ATRICS.—Section 753 of the Public Health Service Act
17 (42 U.S.C. 294c) is amended—

18 (1) in subsection (a)(7)(C), by striking “pub-
19 lically” and inserting “publicly”; and

20 (2) in subsection (d), by striking “\$40,737,000
21 for each of fiscal years 2021 through 2025” and in-
22 serting “\$48,245,000 for each of fiscal years 2026
23 through 2030”.

24 (g) NATIONAL CENTER FOR HEALTH CARE WORK-
25 FORCE ANALYSIS.—Section 761(e)(1)(A) of the Public

1 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 294n(e)(1)(A)) is amended
2 by striking “2021 through 2025” and inserting “2026
3 through 2030”.

4 (h) PUBLIC HEALTH WORKFORCE.—Section 770(a)
5 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 295e(a)) is
6 amended by striking “\$17,000,000 for each of fiscal years
7 2021 through 2025” and inserting “\$18,000,000 for each
8 of fiscal years 2026 through 2030”.

9 (i) INVESTMENT IN TOMORROW’S PEDIATRIC
10 HEALTH CARE WORKFORCE.—Section 775(e) of the Pub-
11 lic Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 295f(e)) is amended by
12 striking “such sums as may be necessary for each of fiscal
13 years 2021 through 2025” and inserting “to carry out this
14 section \$10,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2026 through
15 2030”.
