**A BILL**

To amend the Department of Energy Organization Act with  
respect to functions assigned to Assistant Secretaries,  
and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Energy Emergency  
5       Leadership Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FUNCTIONS ASSIGNED TO ASSISTANT SECRE-**  
2 **TARIES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (a) of section 203 of  
4 the Department of Energy Organization Act (42 U.S.C.  
5 7133(a)) is amended by adding at the end the following  
6 new paragraph:

7 “(12) Energy emergency and energy security  
8 functions, including—

9 “(A) responsibilities with respect to energy  
10 infrastructure, security and resilience, emerging  
11 threats, cybersecurity, supply, and emergency  
12 planning and preparedness, coordination, re-  
13 sponse, and restoration, as appropriate; and

14 “(B) upon request of a State, local, or  
15 Tribal government or energy sector entity, and  
16 in coordination with other Federal agencies as  
17 appropriate, provision of technical assistance  
18 and support to protect against, detect, and re-  
19 spond to energy security threats, risks, and in-  
20 cidents.”.

21 (b) COORDINATION.—The Secretary of Energy shall  
22 ensure that the functions of the Secretary described in sec-  
23 tion 203(a)(12) of the Department of Energy Organiza-  
24 tion Act (as added by this Act) are performed in coordina-  
25 tion with relevant Federal agencies.
