FULL COMMITTEE MARKUP

TUESDAY, MAY 13, 2025 AND WEDNESDAY, MAY 14, 2025

The Committee on Energy and Commerce met, pursuant to notice, at 2 p.m., a quorum being present, for a markup in the John D. Dingell Room, 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building, Hon. Brett Guthrie (Chairman of the committee) presiding. The business before the Committee was to consider legislative recommendations to comply with the reconciliation directive included in section 41001 of H. Con. Res. 14, the Concurrent Resolution on the Budget for Fiscal Year 2025. The following actions were taken:

1. <u>Subtitle A – Energy</u>, was transmitted favorably to the Committee on Budget, without amendment, by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 29-24 (Final Passage).

The following amendments were offered during consideration of Subtitle A:

- Amendment #1 (ENERGY_62VC2_01), offered by Ms. Castor (D-FL), was defeated by a roll call vote of 24-30.
- Amendment #2 (ENERGY_97AU7_01), offered by Ms. Ocasio-Cortez (D-NY), was defeated by a roll call vote of 24-28.
